- You will also be a liaison to one of the Chapel standing committees and attend their monthly meetings (see Trustee Expectations on the back of this letter)

Big Canoe Chapel is our place of worship of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, a place of fellowship, a place of beautiful Christian music, a place of teaching and learning about God's Word. Our Chapel needs caretakers — individuals committed to fulfilling its vision to grow our relationship with God.

BIG CANOE CHAPEL TRUSTEE EXPECTATIONS

1. Model Christ-like living in all areas of your life in response to God's grace.
2. Provide appropriate leadership in board meetings, knowing that leadership gifts may be expressed in many ways. #
3. Attend board meetings as a priority and participate actively (10 or more/year) *
4. Serve on Chapel committees as assigned, serving as a liaison between the committees and the Board of Trustees, and providing appropriate leadership within that area of the Chapel's ministry. *
5. Demonstrate leadership through faithful stewardship of time, talents and financial resources, in the support of God's work at Big Canoe Chapel. #
6. Regularly participate in worship and other programs of the Chapel. #
7. Give priority to Chapel responsibilities and events. #
8. Work cooperatively and respectfully as servant leaders with all Board of Trustee members.
9. Support the Chaplains and staff in the administration of the Chapel's mission.
10. Attend all training sessions and retreats for the Board of Trustees.
11. Be available to serve communion. #
12. Through practices of discernment, and under the guidance of God's Holy Spirit, seek to make decisions together as a board reflecting God's will for Big Canoe Chapel.
