## From the Senior Chaplain

In the first chapter of Ephesians, Paul prays a magnificent prayer for the church. It's a prayer that reflects his love and care for a people seeking to advance the Kingdom of God on earth in all they say and do. I hope someone is praying a similar prayer for me every day. The prayer is found in Ephesians 1:17;

**“I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know Him better.”**

Paul's prayer seems to indicate to me that we all are on a spiritual continuum. The depth of God's love, grace, and power are unfolding realities in the life of the believer. Paul's prayer almost sounds like exhortation----“Don't stop now. Keep praying and seeking God with all your heart. Don't miss out on His wisdom and revelation as the Father propels us in our faith!” I think Paul knew something about the continuum of the faith journey. Even the apostle could declare in **Philippians 3:10**, “I want to know Christ and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in His sufferings, becoming like Him in His death, and so, somehow, to attain to the resurrection from the dead.”

Think about that for a moment. At one time in my life, I thought Paul was far enough along on the continuum of faith that everything was settled and he could spiritually coast the rest of the way. Not so! I'm sure if the question were asked, “Paul, where do you go from here?” His bold and immediate response would have been, “I want to know Christ. I want to live in the fresh and living glory of His presence. I want to go on with God!

I hope that's our desire. Not simply to know about Christ or to accumulate information concerning Christ. But to know Him in the fullness of His glory!
