The Chapel supports, encourages, and prays for **missionaries and ministries at home and around the world.** Whether it's in the House of Grace in Thailand or Ghana or the Music Mission Kiev in the Ukraine, the church is serving as the hands and feet of Christ in many places and proclaiming the good news of a timeless Gospel.

This week we have a team going to Rotario, Nicaragua to work on several projects. One of those projects will focus upon the provision of clean water for the area.
