From the Senior Chaplain

Today we join Christians around the world in the celebration of Holy Communion. World Communion Sunday is a powerful testimony of the Church to reaffirm her commitment to unity in **Christ. Jesus has prayed like this in John 17, “May they (all believers) be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.”** While unity respects cultural differences, worship styles, and denominational practices, we have been called to a life that is, “like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose.” As we receive the elements symbolic of the blood and body of **Christ, I hope our corporate prayer would be, “Lord, make me the instrument of peace and unity that will bring honor and glory to your name.”** I’m convinced that such a prayer from the sincerity of our hearts will be fully answered.

Next Sunday we will launch the 2015 Chapel stewardship campaign. We will be focusing much of our attention upon various passages found in 2 Corinthians 8 and 9. I love the Macedonian churches. They didn’t want to be left out of the offering directed toward the church in Jerusalem. They were not compelled by Paul to give nor did they give out of mere obligation. Their attitude was described like this in 2 Corinthians 8:3, “**Entirely on their own, they urgently pleaded with us for the privilege of sharing in this service to the saints.**” I believe such a heart was the result of a life lived in absolute faith and trust found in the One who is, “able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.”

Thank you for living in that same faith and trust. And thank you for abounding in every good work.
