## From the Senior Chaplain

Recently I was reminded of a set of nearly two dozen questions that John Wesley gave to members of his discipleship groups. Sometimes these questions need to be asked by every Christian. In fact, they need to be asked more often than not. We all know honesty is the best policy and that is just as true in our spiritual lives as in every other area. Small and trusted accountability groups within the church lead us toward mature discipleship. Mature discipleship reflects the nature of Christ. I hope there is someone in your life who loves and respects you enough to hold you accountable and vice versa. Here are some of the questions Wesley published in 1781.

1. Am I consciously or unconsciously creating the impression that I am better than I really am? In other words, am I a hypocrite?
2. Can I be trusted?
3. Am I a slave to dress, friends, work or habits?
4. Did the Bible live in me today?
5. Do I give the Bible time to speak to me every day?
6. Am I enjoying prayer?
7. Do I pray about the money I spend?
8. Do I disobey God in anything?
9. Do I insist upon doing something about which my conscience is uneasy?
10. Am I defeated in any part of my life?
11. Am I jealous, impure, critical, irritable, touchy or distrustful?
12. How do I spend my spare time?
13. Am I proud?
14. Is there anyone whom I fear, dislike, disown, criticize, hold a resentment toward or disregard? If so, what am I doing about it?
15. Is Christ real to me?

The psalmist prayed, “Search me, O God.” I think it’s the appropriate prayer to pray fairly often. I think I will.
