

## Mission Moment- Camp Sunshine Sally Hale

Big Canoe Chapel Mission Moments highlights Camp Sunshine as one of the Missions we support. Sally Hale will present the Mission Moment today. She is a Pediatric Oncology Nurse and has been involved with Camp Sunshine since the beginning in 1983 and has been the Director since 1987.

Dorothy Jordan, a pediatric nurse, founded Camp Sunshine in 1982. It began as a summer camp for children with cancer in 1983 with 44 children. Today, over 400 campers and 220 volunteers participate in two weeks of summer camp held on the 500 acre facility in Rutledge, GA. What makes this camp feasible for the children is that it features 24-hour medical care with pediatric oncology professionals who administer medication, chemo and other treatments while the children still participate in camp activities.

Throughout the year, children with cancer and their families benefit through a variety of recreational programs, including family camp weekends, pre-school programs, teen retreats and activities, young adult programs, family support nights, a sibling camp, bereavement family support and retreats for families. They also offer a program in the local children's hospitals - "Sunshine 2U", which includes 144 programs over 188 days with more than 7,200 participants. They reach about 850 families each year. Camp Sunshine works closely with Chaplains from hospitals who recommend them to the families of children with cancer.

Needing a venue to offer all of its programs, Camp Sunshine built and opened the Camp Sunshine House in 2003 in Decatur. This unique non-residential facility is the perfect meeting place for children with cancer and their families to come together for comfort, friendship and encouragement. Camp Sunshine is committed to providing opportunities for normal development for all children with cancer throughout their journey and bringing together those with similar experiences to share and draw strength from one another.

Big Canoe Chapel Mission Committee is honored to include Camp Sunshine in our funding for 2012.
