

This morning we welcome the Rev. Greg Smith of InStep International

InStep International was formed in January, 2001 by Rev. Smith. InStep develops church leaders, trains national pastors and plants/builds churches in Russia, China, Philippines and Costa Rica. InStep has completed the construction of two churches in Jaco and in San Vito and are now building churches at Yellow River and in Herradura, Costa Rica. InStep is described by Rev. Smith's wife Pam as "Planting trees we may never sit under." God continues to open doors of opportunities whereby many of the people of Costa Rica and other countries can continue to worship God under the guidance of InStep and Rev. Smith.

The Mission Committee is planning a Mission Trip to Costa Rica on October 20-26, 2012. Rev. Smith will host the trip and will be involved in the trip from beginning to end. He will plan all the logistic needs from airfare, transportation, meals, lodging, etc. The cost for this trip will be approximately \$1,500 per person. The main variable is the airfare. The ultimate goal for the Chapel members wishing to participate in this Mission Trip will be to reach people for Christ through evangelism. They will be working primarily with children in schools and the surrounding communities. Light work projects will also be a part of this trip. Rev. Smith will design the trip to meet the needs of the Costa Rican church partners and the giftedness of our mission team so that the shared goals and objectives will make this an effective trip. Only a passport is needed for this trip.
