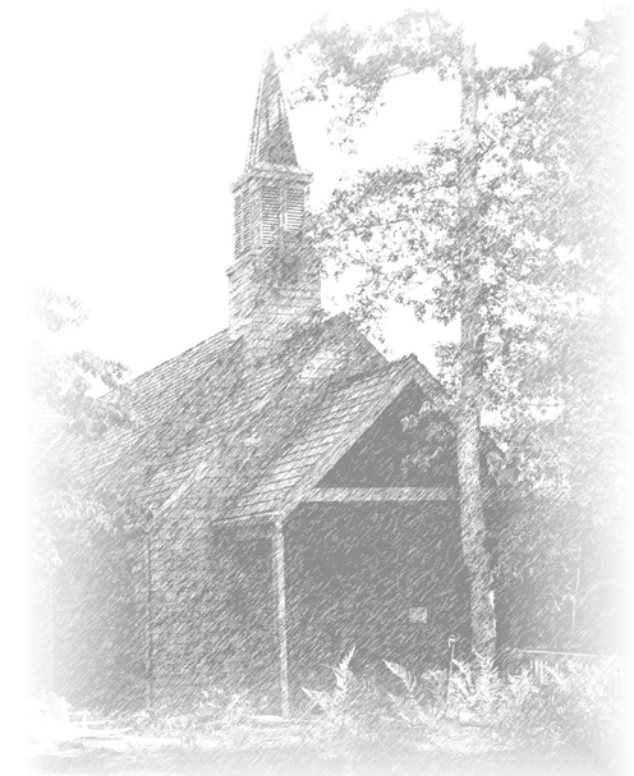

From the Senior Chaplain

Since we will be honoring 103 students on Tuesday evening with Chapel scholarships, I wanted to share this letter with you that is being sent to the Trustees.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank each of you for all your continued support this year. Agreeing to raise the percentage of money distributed to our committee from the Outreach portion of the budget confirmed your support and commitment to 103 students and their families in Dawson and Pickens County. We are awarding \$133,000 from Chapel funds and \$4,000 from anonymous donations this year to 101 students. In addition, \$5,000 is being awarded to five mentoring students who received the promise of a \$1,000 scholarship when they were in 8th grade if they remained in school, graduated with their class, and continued their education after high school. Three of those five students applied for the regular scholarship as well, so the \$1,000 will be added to that scholarship amount.

All students who applied this year met the required qualifications. We are so pleased to be able to offer each of them a scholarship. All of them have stories, but we want to share the background of one of the recipients. Our highest award, \$5,000, is going to Amanda Martin from DHS. She lost her mother to cancer her freshman year in high school. Since that time, she and her younger siblings have had to move back in with their non-supportive father. Amanda has worked 30+ hours a week throughout high school to support her family. She bought her own car so that she could get to work and take her siblings to all their activities. While doing this, she has maintained a 97 GPA, taking honors and AP classes, and has been actively involved with the yearbook and FBLA. She is so respected by her peers that she was elected Homecoming Queen. What an amazing young lady!
