The Ladies of Lee under the direction of Debbie and Randy Sheeks will perform a concert at the Big Canoe Chapel on Wednesday, October 13 at 7 PM. Ladies of Lee, the premier women's choir at Lee University (Cleveland, TN), has enjoyed a thriving ministry of choral music for fifty-five years — performing in churches and schools throughout Tennessee, the Southeast, other locations across the U.S. and abroad including: Mexico, Europe, Israel, the Bahamas, Bermuda, Costa Rica, Hawaii, Alaska, and Washington, D.C. In addition, they have performed in other venues such as Rock City in Lookout Mountain, GA, and the Naval Academy in Annapolis, MD. They have been featured performers at the Candlelight Christmas Evenings at the Biltmore Estate in Asheville, NC for twenty years. Comprised of fifty women from across the Lee undergraduate population, the choir performs a variety of a cappella and accompanied sacred literature, drawing from standard choral repertoire, traditional hymns, spirituals, gospel songs, and even recent Christian music.
